

CURRENT UW-MADISON GRADUATE STUDENTS APPLYING FOR THE POPULATION HEALTH OR EPIDEMIOLOGY PROGRAMS

A current graduate student at UW-Madison can apply for the MS or PhD graduate programs in Population Health Sciences. Your first step is to contact the Graduate Program Coordinator, Quinn Fullenkamp (quinn.fullenkamp@wisc.edu) to discuss your background and interest in the Population Health Sciences graduate programs.

Applicants need to submit the following materials before December 1:

1. A completed *Application for **Add/Change/Discontinue Program** for Currently Enrolled Graduate Students* found online at: <https://grad.wisc.edu/documents/forms/>. The Add/Change Program form is found on under “Forms”.
2. The Population Health Sciences **Supplementary Application**. This application is available from Quinn Fullenkamp. Please email quinn.fullenkamp@wisc.edu and ask for a copy of this application.
3. A **statement of purpose**/reasons for pursuing graduate studies in Population Health or Epidemiology (No more than 1 single-spaced page, and this is part of the Supplemental Application.)
4. A current **CV** including a list of any publications.
5. An unofficial copy of all **transcripts**.
6. 3 **letters of recommendation**. At least 2 of the letters must be current. 1 letter may be recycled from your current program.

→ **Neither of our Graduate Programs are requiring GRE scores for the Fall 2022 class.**
